ACT ONE

JAE

KEITH NELSON (62), slender man with back-length dreads, wears jeans and t-shirt, NICOLE BROWN (50), medium build woman with neck-length hair, wears a green dress, and CELESTE HOGAN (35), stout woman with hazel eyes and freckles enter. ACT TWO

INT. VILLAGE HOME - DINING ROOM - EVENING

DANIELLE

Come here, please.

LENA CAMERON (11), DUANE (Duke) BROWN (11), MADISON (Maddie) COLEMAN (10), and ANDREW (Andy) COLEMAN (12) all run into the dining room to meet Danielle.

They stand there, smile and play while Danielle rushes with dishes in hand.

DANIELLE (CONT'D)

Okay my lovelies, don't just stand
there gawking at me; how about some
help? Who's night to set the
tables, and gather the children?

The four of them look at each and then at Danielle. Then they all run off to check the Chore Chart.

LENA

Tee-Tee, I need your help with my
homework.

DANIELLE

Sweet girl, after dinner. But now,
Tee-Tee needs your help in
gathering the others. Five minutes
everyone!

MADDIE

Tee-Tee, tables set and high-chairs
in place. And, why do I have to
still sit at the kids' table?

KEITH

Because you're still a kid, my
girl.

MADDIE

enough to sit at the adult table.

KEITH

Madison, we're not having this discussion. Have a seat, now!

Maddie storms off and Keith attempts to storm after her.

DANIELLE

Tsk. Tsk. Keith? I'll talk to her later. Celeste! Nicole! Dianne! Dinner's ready.

KEITH

Dianne's not here. I believe she's working. Can we please eat?!

KYLE HOGAN (7), DEON FRAY (6), SARAH BROWN (7), TYGER BROWN (5), PETE BROWN (4), DANIEL and ELLA SHELBY (2) race into the dining room.

CELESTE

Y'ALL STOP RUNNING IN THIS HOUSE!
LENA, KYLE AND JAE, Y'ALL BETTER NOT BE RUNNING! Daniel? Ella? Where are you? Where are they?

PAUL SHELBY (38), muscular-tone man with mahogany-skin enters, and wears camel khaki slacks and a purple polo shirt. He holds a vase of blue and white roses in one hand and a large bag in the other.

PAUL

Celeste, they are down here; baby girl has that look in her eye, so come on down.

All the children look up and greet their Uncle Paul, while the twins run toward him.

Nicole and Celeste greet Paul, and each take a twin. Keith stand there in a daze until Danielle takes her seat.

DANIELLE

Keith, why don't you give the blessing, please.

PAUL

Hey baby, come here girl.

DANIELLE

Hi honey, you're weighed down. Let me help you.

PAUL

No dear, I'll do it. I see you've outdone yourself again.

ACT THREE

INT. VILLAGE HOME - FAMILY ROOM - NIGHT

Celeste and Keith clean the dishes in the kitchen with the older children. Nicole corrects and checks homework. Danielle, Paul, and the smaller children sit in the family room.

JAE

Tee-Tee, can I stay with you tonight?

DANIELLE

Not tonight sweet girl. You have school tomorrow.

PAUL

Sweet girl, can I borrow Tee-Tee for tonight? I promise to give her back tomorrow night.

JAE

Nope, not gonna happen. My Tee-Tee.

Jae hugs Danielle and refuses to let go. Lena comes in and interrupts.

LENA

Tee-Tee! Are you going to help me with my homework now? You did say after dinner. I have a project due.

Danielle raises an eyebrow, hugs Jae, and questions Lena.

DANIELLE

When is the project due, Lena?

LENA

Tomorrow.

DANIELLE

TOMORROW! Dammit Lena, when did you get the assignment?

LENA

Tee-Tee, please don't curse at me. Two weeks ago.

PAUL

Lena, stop waiting until the last minute to ask for help on your projects!

LENA

I'm sorry Uncle Paul. I'm sorry Tee-Tee. Will you please help me this time?

PAUL

Danielle, don't take too long. You owe me some time too.

DANIELLE

Paul, I ...

Paul scoffs, walks away, and leaves Danielle and Lena in the family room.

CELESTE

Brother? Paul? What is it?

PAUL

Lena has a project due tomorrow, and just asked "Tee-Tee" for her help. And of course, it's "Tee-Tee" to the rescue!

CELESTE

She did what! I'm gon beat her ass. I keep telling her to stop waiting until the last minute with stuff.

PAUL

Good night Celeste, Nicole. Keith. Good night children.

CHILDREN

Good night Uncle Paul.

Danielle nods off. Keith walks Nicole and the children home, and then walks Maddie and Andy home. After they go inside, Keith returns to lock up.

CELESTE
